

Fitting notes for Mini-beast trapdoor



Pack contents:

- Mini-beast trapdoor
- 2x wood pegs
- Bark bundle

Tools required for fitting:

- Hammer

Find an area of garden with natural shade, which will help to ensure that the soil under the trapdoor remains relatively damp and cool. Place the loops of rope into the grooves in the pegs and hammer pegs into the ground until the grooves are well below the surface (this will hold the trapdoor into place).

It is important to teach/supervise the children in the correct use of the trapdoor. For example, the trapdoor should not be stood on and must always be lowered carefully back to the ground when finished with, in order to avoid harming the mini-beasts!
