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Fitting notes for: - Story Teller's Chair

## Tools required for fitting:-

Digging Equipment  
Fixing materials

Before any digging is carried out it is important to make sure there are no existing services buried beneath the desired placement points, i.e. electric, gas, water or drainage pipes. (Look for existing manhole covers as a clue.)

Check existing plans for services.

*Keep the oak planks on the bottom of the feet.* Place the story teller's chair where you wish to site it. Using a spade, mark a trench the width of the legs and the length of the body of the chair (see fig. 1 & 2).

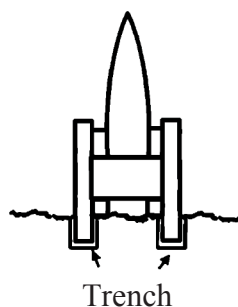

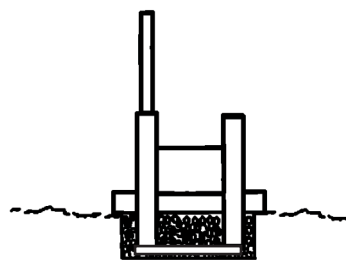

Between at least two people, move the chair to one side whilst digging the holes. Remove turf and place aside for later use. The two trenches should be fractionally wider than the legs and the depth of the legs up to the cross supports.

Carefully lower the chair into the holes. Look to see if it is level and adjust where necessary. Back fill with soil and reinstate the turf.

## **IMPORTANT FOR SAFETY REASONS:-**

If the Chair is **not to be fitted**, the legs **must** be removed up to the level of the cross supports. The cross supports **must** be left on to create stability.
